J-SEI's Journey with Meals on Wheels of Contra Costa

Meals on Wheels of Contra Costa is delighted to spotlight our dedicated partner, J-SEI, in this summer's feature story. Celebrating over 50 years of service, J-SEI has evolved from its humble beginnings into a cornerstone of support for seniors, providing not only nourishing meals but also a deep sense of community.

In a recent interview, Kathleen Wong, Senior Nutrition Manager at J-SEI, shared insights into their inspiring journey and the significant impact of our partnership. "J-SEI began as the East Bay Japanese for Action (EBJA)," Kathleen recounted, "to serve the Issei generation, the first Japanese Americans, with events and resources." Over the decades, J-SEI's mission expanded, merging with other Nikkei groups and evolving into a multicultural and multigenerational hub while maintaining its Japanese roots.

J-SEI's home-delivered meal program has seen impressive expansion in Contra Costa County. "We started off delivering to about 20 seniors in West County, Richmond, and El Cerrito areas. Now, we serve over 70 seniors in West and Central Contra Costa County, including Walnut Creek, Pleasant Hill, and Concord," Kathleen shared. This expansion underscores J-SEI's commitment to addressing community needs, particularly for those who yearn for the comfort of traditional Japanese meals. "Delivering these meals means so much to the seniors. They get a sense of home, of their heritage, in every meal," she noted.

Our collaboration with J-SEI, which began in 2014, has been pivotal in their growth. "Meals on Wheels of Contra Costa came through at the peak of our growth. Their funding and confidence in us helped us to prepare and embrace this growth," Kathleen expressed. This partnership has not only provided financial backing but also instilled a deep sense of assurance within the J-SEI team, empowering them to expand their service capacity and community impact.

J-SEI's success is a collaborative effort, "It takes a lot of different resources to run this program. Not

just our amazing staff and volunteers, but also our partnerships with nonprofit organizations," Kathleen emphasized. She highlighted that J-SEI is the only meal provider offering hot, ethnic Japanese meals in Contra Costa County, a unique service that is cherished by the seniors they serve.

As J-SEI continues to grow, they remain steadfast in their mission to deliver nutritious, culturally meaningful meals while fostering a vibrant sense of community. "Knowing that we are able to expand our reach in Contra Costa County and bring a taste of home to more seniors is incredibly rewarding," Kathleen concluded.
